A spotting disk does not show the shooter where the projectile passed through the target

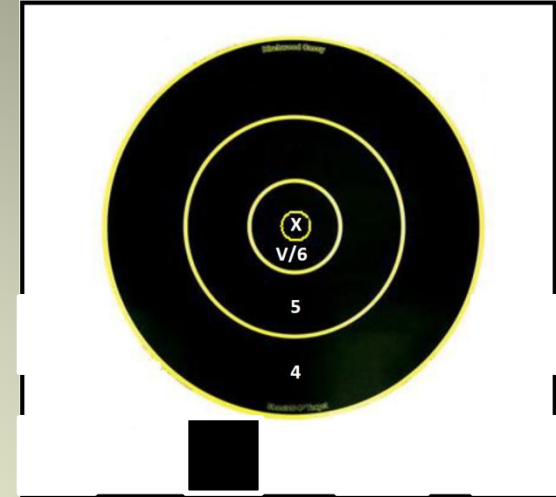

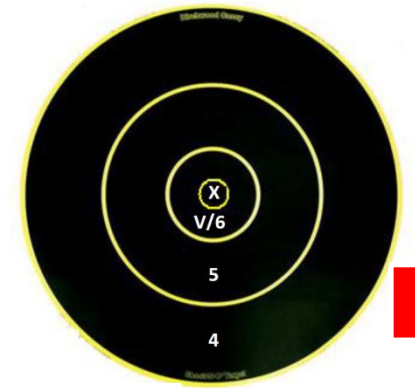

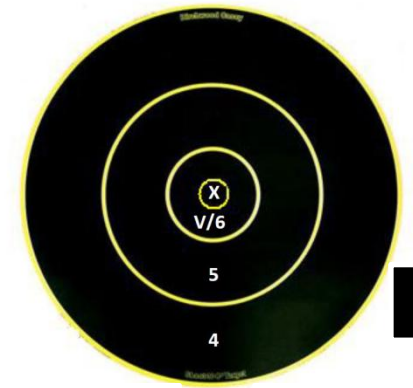

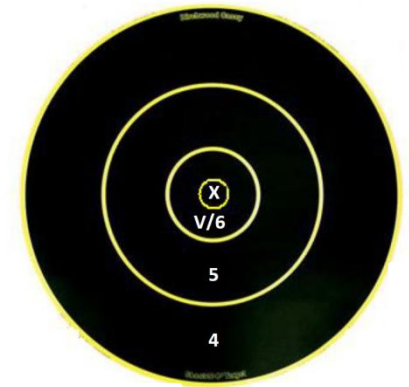

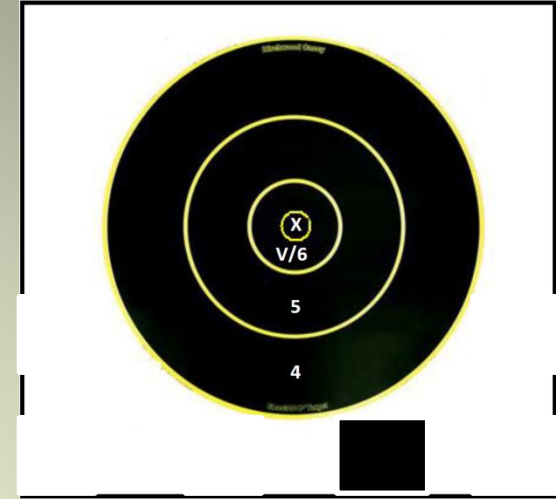

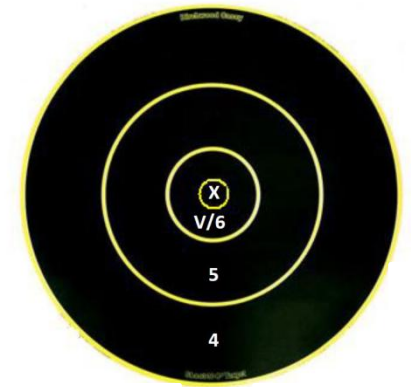
